





Grape Variety Malbech (red grape).

Description This grape variety, of French origin, arrived in

Italy in the mid 800's, and a little later, spread to the eastern areas of the Veneto region. Here, it found a habitat par excellence. It is a rustic variety, hardy enough, but rarely

cultivated in other areas in Italy.

Sensory Notes Ruby red in color with violet hues. Vinous and

fruity, with hints of blackcurrant, blackberry, cherry and preserves. Slightly herbaceous, low in tannins and acidity, this wine is structurally

smooth and enveloping.

Pairings Pairs well with red meats, grilled or roasted,

aged cheeses and cured meats.
