

SAUVIGNON

Grape Variety Sauvignon (white grape).

Description A native French wine which is among the most popular wines in the world due its adaptability to different climates and soils.

Sensory Notes A firm wine, well-structured with herbaceous and persistent earthy scents with added notes of exotic fruits. A wine to be enjoyed before it has aged, preferably so that it will not lose its aromatic characteristics. A straw yellow color with greenish hues.

Pairings Served as an aperitif or with light appetizers. Accompanies soup, such as minestroni, well. Great with asparagus and vegetables, or fish based dishes.
